Services

HSASP serves state and federally funded healthy start and after school programs in the tricounty region. HSASP provides:

- On-site program assessment and recommendations
- Training for school and district administrators, teachers, paraprofessionals, and support staff in program development, school staff training, program sustainability, and partnership building
- Ongoing post-training consultation and coaching in the above areas

Eligibility Requirements

After School and Healthy Start programs in county public K-12 schools are eligible for HSASP services.
